It is with great joy that we will be able to welcome on June 6th in this month of the Sacred Heart, the new parish sisters from the Daughters of the Sacred Heart DSH. Over the last 3 years we have been planning, hoping and praying for this project and now the time has come for their arrival.

How you can help.

There are many ways you can help With prayer, practical support and with financial assistance. Prayer to offer your 1st Friday Holy Communion and Mass for the intentions of the sisters. Practically by offering lifts to the sisters, or food or asking them what they need eg a bag of rice etc. Financial -We need to pay the rent each month which cost £450. At present our monthly 2nd collection is just £250 so your financial contribution is essential. The sisters will also be having the standard remuneration set by the Diocese as well as bills/ food/community charge. All donations will be welcome. Parishioners are warmly invited and encouraged to make a monthly donation by direct debit/standing order. Forms are available to assist this. Families with children who will be attending catechism class may like to consider financial assistance so as to cover costs for books/catechetical needs, paper etc. Children need to be enrolled by age group/class

The arrival of the sisters in the parish, begins a new chapter in the development of the parish and all that happens here, I know you will make them most welcome and will assist them in every way. Let's pray that this new project which is initially for the next three years, may be a source of many blessings and graces for the parish and for the Daughters of the Sacred Heart and a source of vocations from the girls of the Parish.
