Children who are aged 5 now are invited to enrol in September for 2020 1st Holy Communion.

To mark our parish patronal feast of the Sacred Heart and that also of our Parish sisters, the beautiful 40hrs devotion will be held once again from Wed to Sat and concluding with the Procession of the Blessed Sacrament led by our 1st Holy Communion Children on Sunday 8th June. The Precepts of the Church

These are the most basic requirements of what it means to be a Catholic as presented in the Catechism of the Church.

- 1) Attend Mass each Sunday and Day of Obligation.
- 2) To Confess ones sins at least once in the year.
- 3) To receive Holy Communion once in the Year (during the Easter season).
- 4) To marry within the Church ie not to a protestant or non-catholic without permission, not to marry in a protestant building (without permission) or in a civil registry office without a Sacramental blessing/con-validation. Holy Communion cannot be given to those who marry outside of the Church.
- 5) To support the church ministers.
- 6) To observe the days of Fast and Abstinence. Ash Wednesday Good Friday and Fridays of the year (no meat)
