As we open this month of November the Month of Remembrance, it is our duty as Catholics to pray for and remember the Dead. The opening days of November with All saints and all souls Day are special days given to us which remind us of the communion which exists between all the church. Those on earth, those in heaven and those who are undergoing that final purgation of preparation so as to see the one who is all holy and all merciful and all just.

Through November all of us will try to show our love and affection for family members and parishioners who have died and also to show mercy to those who have been forgotten and have no one to pray and assist them. Many of the dead await our prayers and indulgences so as to enter the vision of God and how they will remember us when they are there and come to the awareness that our extra mass or rosary or chaplet assisted their journey to the throne of God.

Each week a family member should be present at one of the events in church to pray for the deceased of the family friends and benefactors.

Week 1 All Souls day, **Week 2** The parish requiem on 7th November, **Week 3** Blessing of Graves at the Cemetery on Sunday 18th, **Week 4** final parish requiem to close the month of November 28th.

Please return your November Dead lists as each day before the mass the names will be read out and prayers after mass will be offered for all those on the November dead list.

On Nov 11th we will have a special Mass for Remembrance Sunday - the Centenary of the Great War, with the Cardiff Bach choir who will sing the beautiful Faure Requiem. Please note that this Mass will take place in the centre so that we can make use of the excellent organ and acoustics Please support this wonderful event on such a significant occasion.
