This pocket-size booklet of prayers and reflections for Lent 2024 is now available. Archbishop Mark O’Toole has written a forward to the booklet and recommends it as an aid to prayer. In his introduction we read, ‘This year we celebrate Lent within the context of the *Year of Prayer*, a year of preparation for the Jubilee Year, entitled *Pilgrims of Hope*. We are asked to make the Lord’s Prayer a particular focus, deepening our understanding of and devotion to it. This is what we do on our *Walk With Me* journey through Lent.’ Archbishop Mark continues, ‘The Lord’s Prayer reminds us of that wonderful truth that we are children of God, loved by our Father in Heaven, and thus we enter into Jesus’ own relationship with his Father. God is our Father who loves us more than we can imagine, and who comes to search for us lost sheep, and draws us back to Him through the Death and Resurrection of His Son... What better way of living Lent than by truly entering into this prayer more deeply.’
