- 2. As you are all aware, the new translation comes into effect on the 1st Sunday of Advent, from which day this rota begins. Please make sure you are familiar with the readings and especially make sure you have time before Mass to check the new Lectionary as well as the Bidding Prayers.
- 3. Further to that point, Father Jason has said that on Feast Days the format of the Lectionary is less straightforward. It is even more important, therefore, to make sure you know where the readings are before Mass, especially if there is a Holy Hour preceding the Mass. If you are unable to be there early enough, please check it on the Sunday preceding the Feast.
