The next chance for all MPs to vote on the *Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill* will most probably take place towards the end of April. The Bishops' Conference have asked us to let you know that, before then, parishes will receive postcards from *Right To Life*. These could be placed at the back of churches for people to send to their MP asking them to use this opportunity to vote against the Bill. In the lead-up to the vote, there will be a pastoral letter issued England and Wales the weekend of 5th/6th April. This will happen in all dioceses .
