All respond: Thanks be to God.

The Lord's Prayer: Our Father...

*leader :* Let us now pray for God's blessing upon us and upon this wreath.

Lord our God,

we praise you for your Son, Jesus Christ:
he is Emmanuel, the hope of the peoples,
he is the wisdom that teaches and guides us,
he is the Savior of every nation. Lord God,
let your blessing come upon us
as we light the candles of this wreath.
May the wreath and its light
be a sign of Christ's promise to bring us salvation;

may he come quickly and not delay. We ask this

through Christ our Lord R. Amen.

## Blessing of a nativity Scene

All make the sign of the cross as the leader says:

Leader: Our help is in the name of the Lord. R/. Who made heaven and earth.

READING from the Holy Gospel according to Luke

In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered. <sup>2</sup> This was the first registration and was taken while Quirinius was governor of Syria. <sup>3</sup> All went to their own towns to be registered. <sup>4</sup> Joseph also went from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to the city of David called Bethlehem, because he was descended from the house and family of David. <sup>5</sup> He went to be registered with Mary, to whom he was engaged and who was expecting a child. <sup>6</sup> While they were there, the time came for her to deliver her child. <sup>7</sup> And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in bands of cloth and laid him in a manger, because there was no place in the guest room.
